PHYSICAL EXAMINATION: GENERAL APPEARANCE: She is a healthy-looking, 1-month-old infant. VITAL SIGNS: Length is 22-1/4 inches, weight is 9 pounds. Head circumference 14-1/2 inches. HEENT: Head is normocephalic. Anterior fontanelle is open and flat. Red-orange reflexes are positive in both eyes. Extraocular muscles are intact. Nose is clear ...

Newborn Physical Exam Medical Transcription Samples

Before even touching the infant, notice the following: color, posture/tone, activity, size, maturity, and quality of cry. This infant has a normal pink color, normal flexed posture and strength, good activity and responsiveness to the exam, relatively large size (over 9 pounds), physical findings consistent with term gestational age (skin, ears, etc), and a nice strong cry.

The sequence in which the nurse conducts the physical assessment is a matter of personal preference and most often depends on the cooperation of the newborn. Although we present the newborn assessment as a sequential examination covering one system at a time, the exam can be appropriately conducted in a cephalocaudal fashion, system by system, and more than one system concurrently.

The doctor usually gives the newborn a thorough physical examination within the first 24 hours of life. The examination begins with a series of measurements, including weight, length, and head circumference.The average weight at birth is 7 pounds (3.2 kilograms), and the average length is 20 inches (51 centimeters), although there is a wide range that is considered normal.

CHARTING EXAMPLES FOR PHYSICAL ASSESSMENT SKIN, HAIR AND NAILS Skin pink, warm, dry and elastic. No lesions or excoriations noted. Old appendectomy scar right lower abdomen 4 inches long, thin, and white. Sprinkling of freckles noted across cheeks and nose. Hair brown, shoulder length, clean, shiny. Normal distribution of hair on scalp and perineum.

One additional facet of global assessment is the relation of physical findings to the time of their occurrence. Today's normal signs may be tomorrow's abnormalities. Immediately after birth, the obstetrician needs to ascertain, from a brief assessment of the infant, whether there is illness or malformation.

The Normal Neonate: Assessment of Early Physical Findings ...

Infant Physical Assessment 1. EYES Normal Findings: Inner Canthus distance approximately 2.5 cm, horizontal slant, no epicanthal folds. Outer canthus aligns with tips of the pinnas. Abnormal Findings: Wide-set position, (hypertelorism), upward slant, and thick epicanthal folds suggests Down's Syndrome.
