Double-spaced paragraphs A header with author's last name and page number one-half inch from the top of each page.

MLA Format for Essays and Research Papers

Heading and Title. An MLA-formatted research paper does not need a title page (unless your instructor requires one, of course). Instead, include at the top of your first page a heading - consisting of your name, your instructor's name, the course number, and the date - and the title of your paper.

Always start with Heading 1, then add other Heading levels for sub-sections of that section. For instance, if I use Heading 1 for my first point "A History of Sasquatch", I'd only use Heading 2 for sub-sections of that section.
