General 4.1.1 The Warehouse & Distribution Services approach is defined as the process of managing and performing Warehouse and Distribution Center processes in an effective manner to ensure the timely distribution of need parts/materials/products to fill Customer orders.

Warehouse & Distribution Services Procedure

The process commences when operators accept the put-away task from the Enterprise Resource Program (ERP) or Warehouse Management System (WMS), and then scanning the relevant barcode of goods to be put away. If there is no barcode, then a manual entry can confirm that the goods have been identified.
